Political Campaign Intern- Baltimore County

The Maryland League of Conservation Voters, a statewide non-partisan environmental advocacy organization, seeks two interns to assist in running electoral field campaigns in Baltimore County in general election races for the General Assembly in Maryland. Responsibilities will include recruiting, engaging, and tracking the work of a committed group of volunteers. She or he will be responsible for organizing phone banks, literature drops and “Get out the Vote” (GOTV) activities.

Primary Responsibilities Include:

- Identify and recruit volunteers.
- Activate volunteers to engage environmental voters for MD LCV endorsed candidates.
- Coordinate and manage aspects of field campaign such as: phone banks, literature drops, and GOTV.
- Coordinate outreach at events such as farmers markets, neighborhood festivals, and etc.
- Plan, assist in and coordinate earned media activities such as press events and letters to the editor.

The following skills are required for the successful applicant:

- Strong outreach and public speaking skills.
- Enthusiasm about working to elect pro-conservation candidates and engaging volunteers and voters.
- Ability to work independently and communicate regularly with a team.

The following skills and experience are preferred for the successful applicant:

- Experience working with volunteers or working on campaigns.
- Experience with environmental issues and/or politics.
- Knowledge of/experience with Baltimore County
- Working knowledge of Microsoft Excel, Google Documents as well as database programs.

Limited stipends are available for transportation costs and credit from universities where available.

Position Requirements: The position is based in Baltimore county and will require travel. Evening and weekend hours are required to be successful. Your own reliable transportation is an advantage.

Availability: We seek to have the successful candidate start by September 1, 2010. The successful candidate will be able to dedicate 15-25 hours a week to the campaign. Orientation is August 29, 2010 in our Annapolis office.
